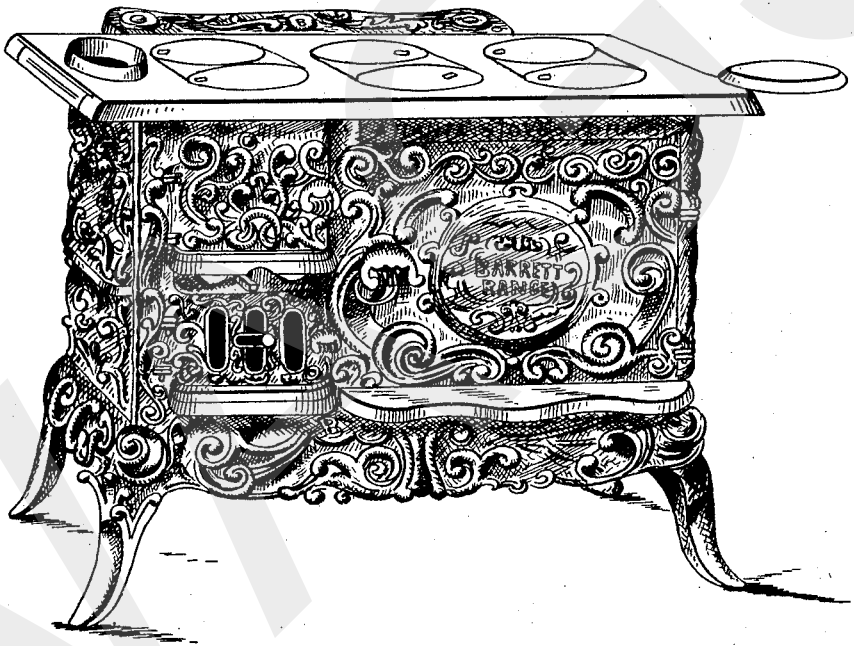

## DESIGN FOR A COOKING RANGE OR STOVE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 36,894, dated April 26, 1904.

Application filed March 22, 1904. Serial No. 199,483. Term of patent 14 years.
