

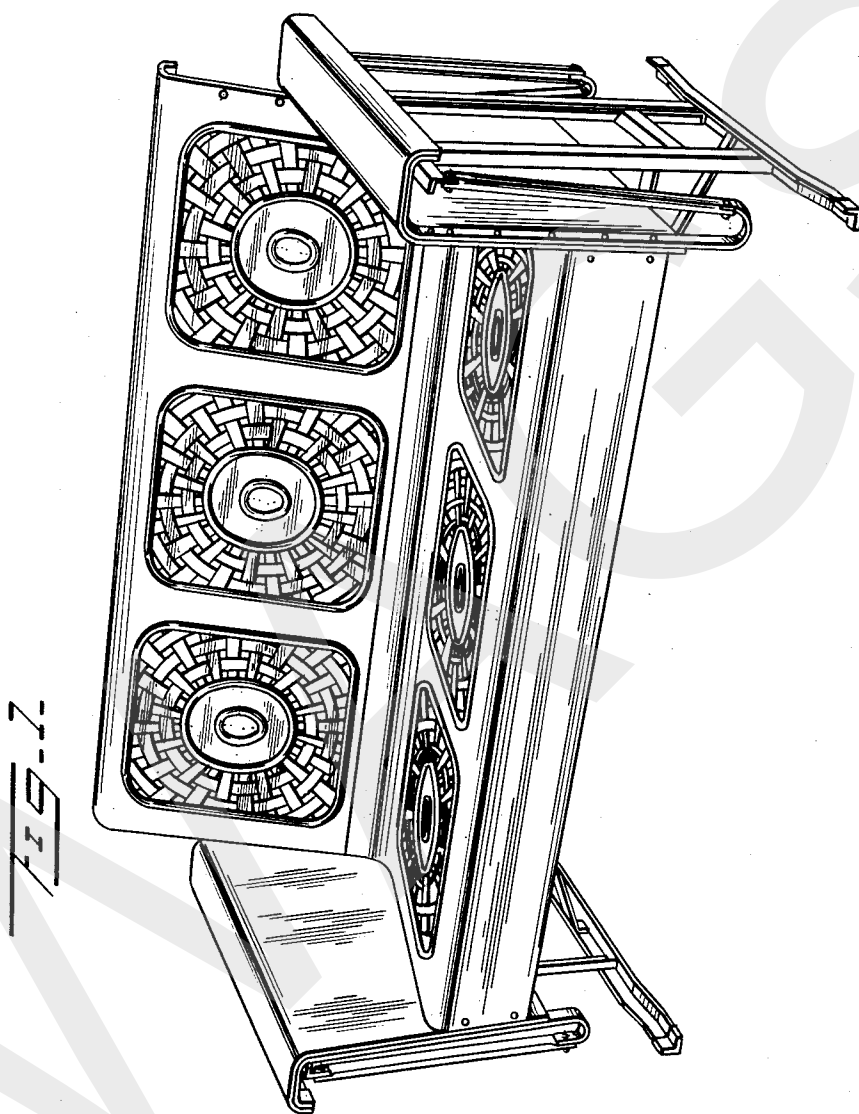

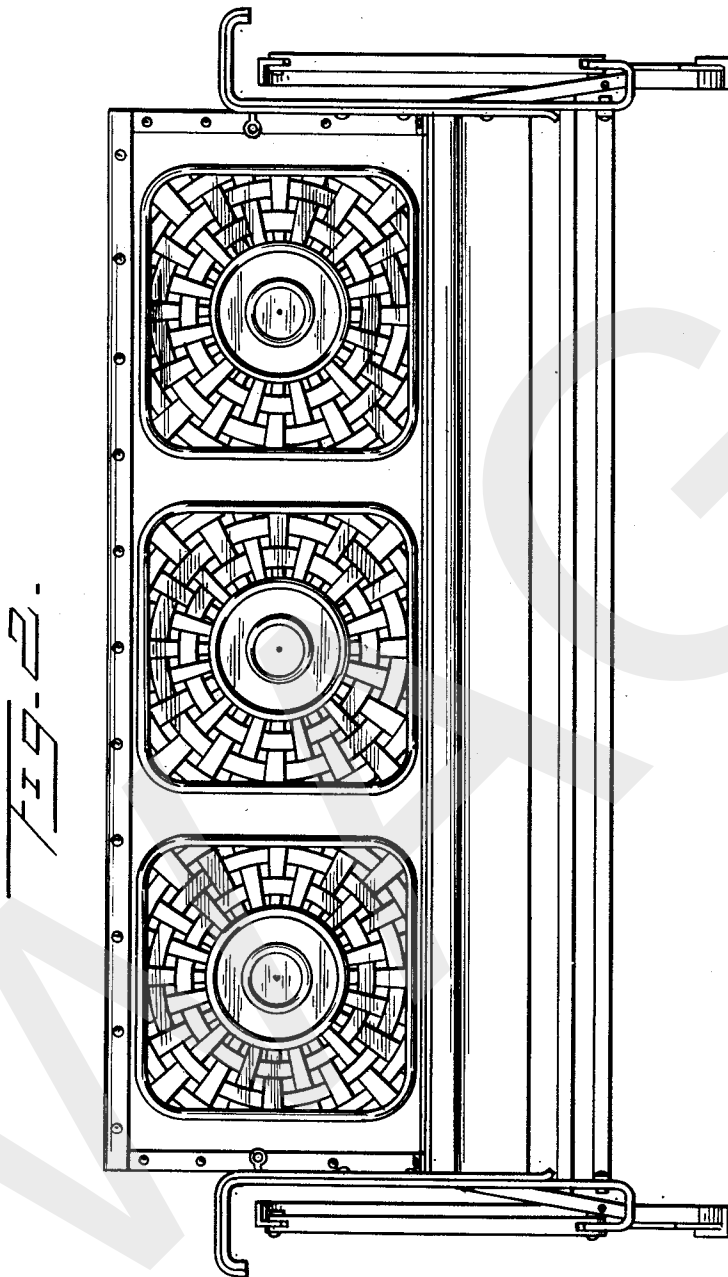

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Jay Fred King, a citizen of the United State of America, residing at Atlanta, in the county of De Kalb and State of Georgia, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Porch Glider, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a perspective view from the front of a porch glider showing my new design,

Figure 2 is a rear elevational view of the same.

The characteristic features of the design reside in the ornamental pattern of the back and seat panels as shown.
